

Information about Travel Grants for SDS Summer School 2026

The IHU Strasbourg offers 2 Travel Grants to contribute towards the cost of attending the annual SDS Summer School.

The expenses covered by the travel grant include travel, accommodation, and registration fee. Accommodation will be booked by the IHU Strasbourg. Travel expenses will be reimbursed, based on real cost, to a maximum of 500€ for EU candidates and 1 500€ for non-EU candidates.

Application Information

Who is eligible?

- Applicants from conflict-affected countries
- Applicants from low or middle-income countries ([List](#))

Application process

Applications for the Travel Grant should be submitted along with the application to Summer school and should include:

- A short motivation letter for travel grant application
- A signed letter from the applicant's institution (e.g., hospital, university, company) stating that no other travel grant is sought to cover the summer school travel, accommodation, and/or registration fees

The deadline for application is March 1st, 2026.

Evaluation

Notifications will be sent out by March 18th, 2026.

Payment

Grants will be paid to applicants after the Summer School, following receipt of an expense claim form and supporting receipts or invoices.
